FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners.

Driving through Deer Park Ave, one will notice the bright and attractive signages that line it attracting commuters to businesses. I notice that even the smaller Churches have it, which makes sense since they would need to make themselves known and their presence felt. It is therefore odd that passing through our property, being such a long stretch that our signages are outdated and unattractive. In fact I have heard some people sharing their experience passing by us, that despite our size, they did not initially realize that there is a Church and School here. It has been suggested by some parishioners that we should update our signage and bring it up to par with the rest. But cost has always been an issue. So we did our research and we have found a company that makes a good sign for a reasonable price. And fortunately, Mangano Funeral Home has generously offered to pay for it. And so in a few weeks we will be installing a new LED programmable signage in front of the main entrance of the Church on Deer Park Ave. It is my hope that this will be one improvement that will make us more visible and prominent, but likewise advertise events that the Parish and School are holding.






