FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

It's the Second Sunday of Lent. 10 days has passed. Let us check our resolve to truly allow ourselves to be strengthened by our Lenten Exercises: How are we in our fasting and abstinence, prayer and alms giving. If we have been sidetracked, we can still get back on track. Let us not think that fasting and abstinence only involve food like chocolate and meat. It may also involve lessening the use of the phone especially when with family and friends or reducing social media use, or cutting negativity. A practical suggestion for prayer. All one needs is 3 to 5 minutes every night (or every morning for that matter). It is just finding a quiet moment with God, just to be with him, share what is in your heart. The key is consistency, and make that "time with God" a fixed and non-negotiable time. And almsgiving can take many forms: sharing time, treasure and talent. If you are interested, email me I have a few ideas to make this happen.

Lenten Regulations for Fasting & Abstaining

All Catholics who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain entirely from meat/ poultry on Ash Wednesday and ALL the Fridays of Lent. All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are also bound to observe the law of fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Two other light meals, which together do not equal a full meal, may be taken during the day.
