FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

As announced last weekend, the following are recent changes in our set up and also a reminder of guidelines that we are all asked to follow.

The northern wing of the Church is now open for private prayer from Monday to Friday from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. This gives time at the end of the day for our maintenance people to clean the Church for the following day. You may enter through the side doors next to the garage.

Following government regulation, we can only allow 10 people at a time to stay in the Church. To assure this, please use only the designated pews to sit on and always maintain social distance all the time. Violators will be asked to leave.

- Please follow signs for Entrance and Exit. Also, please do not cross or remove barriers.
- Face masks should be worn inside the Church all the time. Let us be sensitive and help protect the vulnerable.
- When we have funerals, the Church will be closed for private prayer. Because of the limitation on number, those already in the Church will be asked to leave. The Church will re-open for private prayer right after the funeral is finished.

We have designated the southern wing for confessions every Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm. Penitents are asked to be seated and for your turn at the breezeway. The confessionals will NOT be used. Only 1 penitent may be present in the Church at every time. Those finished are asked to leave the Church immediately to allow for the next penitent to enter. Face masks should be worn during confessions.
