Dear Parishioners,

The drive-in Eucharistic Blessing and adoration of Our Lady of Guadalupe on the Feast of Pentecost was a big success. It was very well attended and there were many who came who were truly moved. We are preparing to do a Drive-in Holy Hour for the Feast of Corpus Christi on Saturday June 13, from 6:00pm to 7:00pm at the southern parking lot (back of the School). We will have an exposition of the Blessed Sacrament under a tent. Attending parishioners will be asked to park in designated parking slots designed so that people are able to see the sacrament and to facilitate ease when one needs to leave. Everyone is expected to stay in the car during the whole hour. Just in case weather does not cooperate, raincheck the following day Sunday, June 14 from 10:30am to 11:30am.

to prepare for it. Currently, we are designing a way to have safe designated distanced seating in the Church for big liturgies. But above all we are making sure the Church is constantly cleaned and sanitized. Our custodians already clean the Church daily by wiping down the designated seating for private prayers including door handles and things frequently touched when people come for prayer. But we have learned that cleaning and sanitizing are two different services. We have previously hired a cleaning company to mop the floors, clean the bathrooms, do some dusting and empty out trash in the Church to prepare for the weekend. This is cleaning. And this time around, we have hired a different company to sanitize the Church every week. This involves spraying the whole church with a solution to kill bacteria in the air and on all surfaces. This is new and because of the size of our Church quite a big expense from what we are already spending for the upkeep of the Church. But since it is a necessity at this time to assure everyone's safety, then we will just have to do it.
