#### FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Since the Church's re-opening and return to the regular Mass Schedule, there has been requests made on an urgent need to set and clarify guidelines for giving communion to the homebound at this time. Please be guided accordingly.

#### Guidelines for Homebound Ministers – in time of Pandemic

- Like before, we will NOT be allowing ministers to request for communion at the communion line. For both Daily and Sunday Masses, we ask that at the beginning of Mass, you put the pyx or pyxides on the silver tray placed at the credence table on the organ side of the sanctuary. At the end of Mass, after the distribution of communion, it will be handed back to you, with a commissioning.
- 2. During this time, we ask that Ministers give communion only to people who they live with in the same household. At this time, to avoid contamination, each homebound Minister must have his/her own pyx. If they do not have one, we will try to provide you with one. We discourage ministers sharing pyxs with one another. We ask that you label the base of the pyx with your name.
- 3. We discourage ministers bringing communion to a different household at this time. We have to be very careful about entering the house of a homebound person. This is to prevent the

#### First Holy Communion:

#### **Confirmation:**

All of our Confirmation parents received an email **<u>last Saturday</u>** with the new date of Confirmation, and the form to order their child's Confirmation gown. A separate email was sent out **<u>this past week</u>** to notify them of the timeslot of the session that they were assigned.

All of our Level 2 and 8 Catechists also called their classes to make sure that all Sacrament information was received, so that we could cover all of our bases! With restrictions being what they are, planning all of these days is an incredibly huge undertaking. As we go through these next two weeks, I am humbly asking all of you for your prayers. minister from bringing anything to the home of the homebound, and vice versa to prevent the minister from contracting anything from the home of the homebound.

- 4. The Diocesan guidelines clearly indicates that one should not wear gloves when giving out the communion. But make sure you use hand sanitizer before and after giving out communion.
- 5. Always use the Simple Communion Rite. Ministers, please pass by the Parish Office to pick up copies of this Communion Rite, so you could also leave your name and contact info and the person/people you are giving communion to.
- 6. We will continue to await directives from the diocese for clearer guidelines to follow on this matter. As soon as we hear from them, we will be sure to disseminate information to those concerned.
