Celebration of Sacraments

We congratulate our children who received the Holy Eucharist for the first time this week. We had 6 first communion sessions this week. This has been long awaited. The delay as everyone knows was because of the restrictions for public gathering due to the pandemic. This time, we have followed strict guidelines to assure that the children and families are safe while making sure that a meaningful and memorable liturgy is celebrated. First Communion is a milestone in the journey of faith of every Christian child, and thus the celebration was carefully planned and the children catechized and prepared so they fully grasp the meaning and value of the Holy Eucharist.

We also pray for our confirmandis who will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on July 31. We need to support them for this is not the end of years of preparation, as they learned about their faith, but the commencement of a new chapter in the journey of discipleship. Now they will be asked to take on a more active role in the propagation of the faith and in the life of the Church. Let us be at hand to encourage and assist them for what's ahead of them.

In the same way, on August 15, those in the RCIA will be receiving the Sacraments they have prepared for the past year. As adults receiving the sacraments of initiation, our responsibility as a Christian community is to welcome them to our worshipping community and to allow them to find themselves in the various ministries that the parish offers.

Safety updates

Just some information on measures being done in the Church and in the school to make sure air quality is safe and secure. We would like to assure everyone that our A/C and Heating company uses **MERV**, one of the most advanced commercial filters in the market, currently used in reputable business establishments, so our parishioners and our school community can feel secure of the air that they breath within our facilities. We are also currently studying and looking at investing on UV light machine technology that will enable us to kill the smallest particles such as viral particles that may be in the air and in surfaces. We continue to update ourselves with what is out there and await recommendations and approval from CDC for the use of other new and upcoming technologies to ensure that people who come to Church for liturgical gatherings or attend our school are safe.
