FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners.

A beautiful place for the statue of the Blessed Mother. Many of you are probably aware that for many years the statue of the Blessed Mother, as donated and venerated by the Rosary Society of Sts Cyril and Methodius, has shared space with the statue of St Gerard Magela (on the right side of the South Wing coming from the Breezeway entrance.) It is quite odd that she was placed there because the stained glass behind that serves as backdrop clearly indicates that it is a spot dedicated to St Gerard. Although I am sure St Gerard would not mind, I still felt that the Blessed Mother's statue deserved a better and more dedicated spot. Besides, we also did not want her there because it meant multiplication of statues of the same Saint since just across the pews is a statue of Our Lady of Innocents, another beautiful image of the Blessed Mother. But finally we have found her a perfect spot that would highlight her beauty and encourage true devotion. She is now moved to the space behind the 2 glass doors in the Southern entrance of the Breezeway. It is quite fitting that she now sees over those entering and leaving the Church, a reminder of the Blessed Mother's role in the Church as mother and quide to us all her children.
