FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Last Thursday, August 6th, on the Feast of Transfiguration, the Holy Father, Pope Francis delivered a message that reminded his listeners that at this event Jesus revealed His Divine Majesty to His disciples, and through them, to all of us. We should therefore obey God's command at the Transfiguration when the voice from heaven said "this is My beloved Son…listen to Him." (Mt 17:5)

The Holy Father invited everyone to "keep their gaze always fixed on the resplendent face of God" in the transfigured Christ on Mount Tabor, because "He is the light that illuminate the events of every day."

Perhaps all we see around us are chaos and confusion. Darkness seem to be taking over every single minute of our lives. As we continue to grapple with the covid-19 pandemic and the devastating effects this has brought to people's lives, we face its painful effects on the economy and how it has torn family by separating them from each other.
