#### FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners.

Last week we went back to distributing Holy Communion in its usual time and place at Mass. Since we might have gotten used to receiving at the end, after the final blessing, here are a few reminders for order:

- 1. Wait for instructions from the ushers when your pew may join the line. You may remain seated while your pew awaits its turn.
- 2. Before leaving your pew make a mental note where you were seated as you will be returning to your seat after communion.
- 3. When your pew is signaled, quietly stand up and join the line. Let us be patient and allow for some distance (6 feet) in front of you as you fall in line.
- 4. When receiving communion by the hand, place both hands flat (not cupped), one on top of the other, so the Minister may easily lay the Body of Christ on it, avoiding contact of his

hands with yours. Be assured that the ministers have been advised to use hand sanitizers right away when contact has been made to avoid contamination.

- 5. Upon receiving the Body of Christ from the Minister of Communion, do not bring it with you to your seat. You must consume it immediately in front of the minister before heading back to your seat.
- 6. After communion, please do not leave the Church right away. Remember that the Mass has not concluded and is incomplete until the Prayer after Communion and the Final Blessing. Please go back to where you were seated, mindful you are not sitting on someone else's previous seat as you await the concluding part of the Mass.

About the Misalettes and Hymn Books.

We are aware that some people prefer to follow the Mass and actively participate using a Misalette. Joining in the singing is also one that many miss and without something to follow the lyrics from, it could be frustrating. We are not able to bring the shared books out as this might cause contamination from and to other users. The Diocese has also advised against "vigorous communal singing" for now. Let us try to be more patient. The Lord knows and sees that our hearts yearn to sing of His praises and to participate at Mass even if there are restrictions for us to do these fully now and that's what truly matters.

You must be intrigued by the blue squares framing the entrance door to the school by the breezeway. Something exciting and beautiful is coming up! Watch out for an announcement soon!
