FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Please note the revised schedule for this year's Christmas Masses and other

sacraments. Christmas eve (Thursday, December 24) Masses will be at 2:00 pm and 4:00 pm and a concelebrated 12:00 Midnight Mass. For safety, we will have an overflow venue in the School Gym and as standby priest to celebrate Mass simultaneously, when needed, for both the 2:00 pm and 4:00 pm Masses once the Church is close to its maximum allowed capacity. Right now, with proper social distancing, we are able to accommodate 300 in the Church, which is 30% of the full capacity. The gym is able to accommodate an additional 100 people. Please note that this year we have canceled the 6:00 pm Mass and added the 2:00 pm Mass instead, assigning it as the family Mass. The Diocese has given us a special permission to hold the Mass as early as 2:00 pm, but only for this year, because of the extra-ordinary circumstance we are all in.
