1st Reading: Exodus 20:1-17 (or shorter form, Exodus 20:1-3,7-8,12-17) Moses is given the Ten Commandments.


2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 1:22-25 Paul preaches Christ crucified to the Corinthians.






