Dear Parishioners,

Last week, Easter Sunday saw a very good turn out in the attendance at all Masses. It truly felt like "the stone that covered the tomb" has been rolled away as people have come to Church from being locked down at home to celebrate faith in the community of faithful as Jesus is risen from the dead. It was truly a joyful and heartwarming sight to behold. I am grateful as well for the humbling generosity that you showed in your financial support for your parish. We pray that this upward trend continues while not keeping our guards down, continuing to be cautious and not failing to follow safety guidelines.

This weekend is 2nd Sunday of Easter and we know it as Divine Mercy Sunday. The Image of The Divine Mercy represents the risen Christ whose hands and feet bear

the marks of the Crucifixion. From the diary of Mother Faustina in her conversation with Jesus, we read: "The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls. ... These two rays issued forth from the very depths of My tender mercy when My agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the Cross" (Diary, 299). In other words, these two rays signify the sacraments of mercy (Baptism and Penance), and the Eucharist. The Eucharist is the blood of souls, carrying life-sustaining food for our spiritual journey. The water is analogous to the sacraments of Baptism and Penance, in that through these sacraments our souls are washed clean.

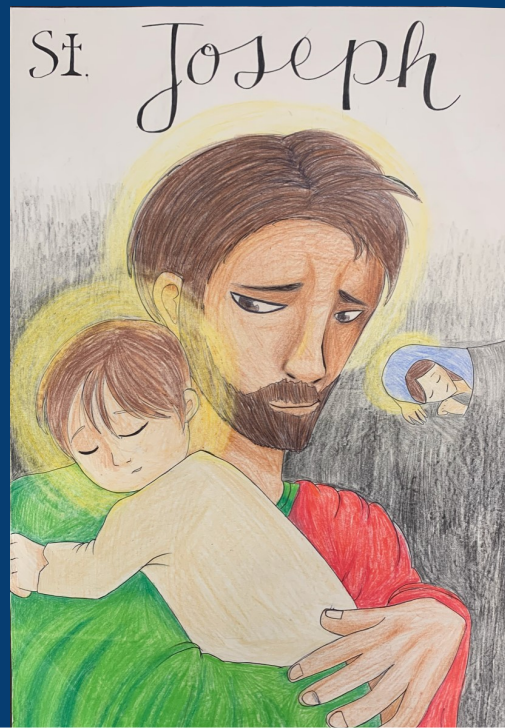

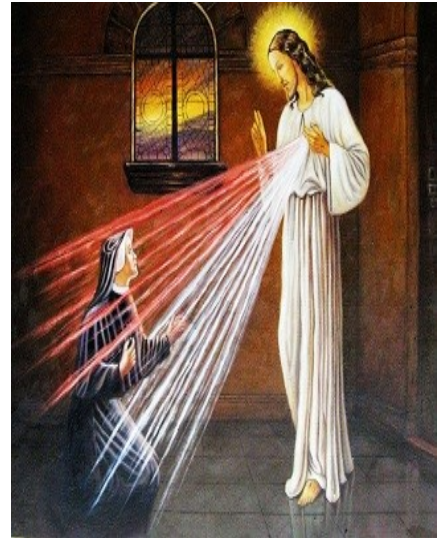

Weekly Greeting from Ms. Laucella

This week concludes the Easter Octave, or the first eight days of the Easter Season. It is also the Feast Day of Divine Mercy, Or Divine Mercy Sunday.

Divine Mercy is a constant theme in scripture, as it focuses on forgiveness. However, Divine Mercy Sunday focuses on the fourteen revelations that Christ made known to Saint Faustina in the 1930s, stating His specific Desire for this Feast. In these encounters with her, Christ revealed that on the Sunday following Easter, “the divine floodgates through which graces flow” are opened, as are the very depths of His Tender Mercy. Christ also conveyed “that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners”. It is a time when all are encouraged to go to Reconciliation, receive Communion, and ask for forgiveness. We wish everyone a Happy Divine Mercy Sunday, and a Blessed Easter Octave!

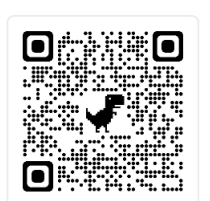

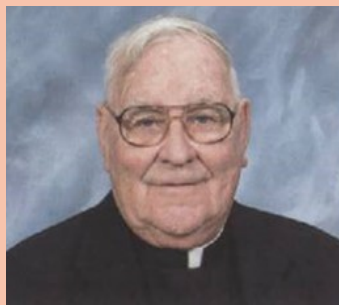
