AN IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT about SSCM Catholic School

Dear Parishioners,

I am writing to you today to share exciting news about the future of Catholic Education in Deer Park and the surrounding area.

For nearly 60 years, Ss. Cyril and Methodious Catholic School has played a vital role in forming generations of young Catholics in the Deer Park area. As you may know, over the past decade our school has faced a serious decline in enrollment. This decline has placed continuing financial pressure on our parish. As financial pressure has mounted, the SSCM community has continually impressed me with its ability to come together to support our school. The hard work of our principal, Sister Susan, our business manager, Deacon Phil, and our staff, along with your donations of time, talent, and treasure have

kept our school open, even during the COVID-19 pandemic. I am proud of what we have done together to continue to serve our children.

Throughout the past year, I have worked with the Morning Star Initiative team and the Department of Education to understand what our school needs to thrive and to consider all options in the best interests of the Parish of Ss. Cyril and Methodius. During this time, I have prayed and reflected on the best path forward.

Today, after careful deliberation with the MSI, DOE and our Diocesan leaders, I am excited to share with you the path forward for Catholic elementary education in our parish.

Next year, Ss. Cyril and Methodious will become part of the first Morning Star Pilot School, with a new name: Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic School of Long Island. You should know that as we have discussed this plan over the last few months, I have been in





Under a new leadership and governance structure, this new school will provide extended school days, language immersion, strong elective programs, and service learning components. Next year, both schools will move forward as one, under the banner of Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic School.

As with all new ventures, I have no doubt people may experience uncertainty. I ask for your patience and understanding as the success of this new model will depend on the continued involvement and input from our entire parish community.




