Congratulations to our boys and girls who were confirmed on May 21, 2021. You all worked hard for this. May you be inspired to exercise the gifts of the Holy Spirit given to you on the day of your Confirmation. Congratulations also to our adult baptized Catholics who have completed their preparations: Francisco Huezo Jr, Angela lannnacchino and Aaron Reuscle who are going to be confirmed this weekend at the 9:30 am Mass on the Solemnity of Pentecost. Let us pray that they may use their gifts for the service of the Church and the community.

New Guidelines from the Diocese of Rockville Centre.

As more and more restrictions are being lifted by the CDC, the diocese has recently issued revisions in the restrictions we have set for the parishes in Long Island. We are implementing these adjustments as we see fit to our concrete circumstances here at Ss. Cyril and Methodius.

1. The dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation Masses remains in effect. It is anticipated that this will be lifted soon. But we are seeing our faithful coming back and we continue to highly encourage the faithful to return to in-person participation in the Holy Mass. sick and the homebound. But we hope for you to come back for there is nothing like the experience of being present with each other in person at Mass.

2. The diocese is now allowing 100% of the Church's capacity. There is a qualification however, as "some" distancing should remain in place which applies more specifically to people who do not belong to the same household. This distance is not a strict magic measured number (6 feet or 3 feet). The underlying principle here is respect and to mindful of people who may not be ready to be in close contact with others. The blue ribbon on every other pew will remain to put some order and structure in maintaining some distance from others. But when necessary

and with some discretion, they may be temporarily removed to accommodate members of the same household to be closer to each other at Mass.

3. Masks should continue to be worn except by children under 2 years of age and those with breathing difficulty.

4. Liturgical Ministers are encouraged, but on a voluntary basis, to resume exercising their ministry. Lectors are very much needed for a number of Sunday Masses. Please call Joan Loring to be included in the schedule. We will continue to limit communion stations to 4 per Mass. We ask our Eucharistic Ministers to please call the

office if you wish to be assigned to any of the Sunday Masses. Likewise, we are recruiting children 4th Grade and up to be trained and become Altar Servers. See the bulletin for details. Ushers are also very much needed at all Masses. Please call Paul Coppola at 631-433-8712 if interested. Finally, the choir will be brought back this year when choir season begins in September.

5. The Sign of Peace is optional in the Roman Rite. In the instruction, it says, "when appropriate." It was suspended in the past to prevent people from going around and possibly making physical contact with the other members of the congregation in attendance. It is, however, my decision to now allow the exchange of peace before the Lamb of God to be resumed beginning Monday, May 24 in all daily and Sunday Masses. However, we need to be reminded that physical contact (such as shaking hands, giving hugs or kisses) to express peace must be limited only to members of one's household. The recommended form of expressing peace is by staying put and bowing/nodding at those in your close proximity.

6. As people have now become aware of the importance of wearing masks, constantly sanitizing hands and avoiding touching the face with non-sanitized hands, beginning this weekend the blue books will now be returned to the pews.

7. Holy water fonts continue to remain empty indefinitely. However, Holy Water is available to the faithful in the Holy Water tank by the sacristy entrance on the lectern side of the sanctuary. Please be reminded that the water is NOT for drinking but is used to bless ourselves and religious items in our homes.
