Dear Parishioners,

Due to the current unsatisfactory circumstances, we are postponing the Banquet at the Inner Garden to a later date. We are sorry for the inconvenience this would bring to those who have already bought their tickets or planning to attend. Unfortunately, we were not able to get enough people to sign up and the date set by our chef as deadline for the final count to prepare well for the banquet was coming up fast. And so, we needed to make 2 adjustments – on the date and the price.

Date: We are moving the event from *Sunday*, July 11 to *Friday*, August 6, still to start at 5:00 pm. Venue is still the same: the Inner Garden at the Rectory Courtyard. This will give enough time for people to consider buying their tickets. This will also give more

time for those who are still uncertain about coming to a gathering to be encouraged to look around and see that it is now ok to be out of the house and be with others in the community. The deadline for buying the tickets is Wednesday, July 28 at 1pm. We are hoping to sell out all the tickets before that date.

Price: The second adjustment is good news. We listened and realized that \$300 may be too steep for many. We really would like to give more people the opportunity to enjoy so many great things that the evening will surely bring. Because of this we have decided to lower the ticket prices. Tickets have now been reduced to \$300 for a couple and \$175 for a single ticket.

Thank you to the four parishioners who donated the wheeled grocery carts for our clients who walk to the pantry. You have no idea how much that has helped them. Walking is difficult enough, walking in the heat and having to manage grocery bags is a very real hardship. As soon as I asked for two I needed two more and with the grace of God we have gotten them.

We have, as you know gotten one of the refrigerators donated. We have gotten donations in totaling \$600.00 toward the second refrigerator. That leaves us with \$1544.00 needed for the second refrigerator. You are very kind and generous parishioners here at Ss. Cyril and Methodius. We were very lucky that one parishioner was able to donate the entire amount for the first refrigerator. I just want you to realize that I realize not everyone has the means to do that. Any amount can be donated towards the next refrigerator.

I also have gotten very good parishioners to deliver food to those who cannot get to the pantry.

I am still looking for the housing and friendly visitors.

Please let me know if you hear of anything. If anyone knows of a one or two bedroom apartment that may be available in the near future please reach out to me. This is for three adults. A couple and their adult son. The wife has cancer and is undergoing chemotherapy. They are currently in a shelter in Wading River. However, her doctors are here in Deer Park and before they lost their home were residents of Deer Park. It is very difficult for them to keep traveling here for her appointments as she is quite ill. The most they can pay is \$1600/mo.

My second request is for a young couple that is pregnant and homeless. They are in need of a one bedroom or even a studio apartment for up to \$1000/mo.

Housing is very hard to come by in the present environment.

Let us always be guided not by what Jesus would do but rather what Jesus wants us to do.

May God Bless you for all you do for the less fortunate in our community.
