Each year our parish participates in the Mission Cooperative. It is an opportunity for us to learn of some missionary works around the globe, all of which benefit from our prayer and support. On the weekend of September 5th, Labor Day weekend, Brother Dennis Lee, FSC will share the work of the De La Salle Christian brothers in Kenya. You may know the De La Salle School in Freeport and you may remember La Salle Military Academy in Oakdale. generous gift to the parish. Their aim is to inspire faith and devotion to all who enter our Church. This will also mark the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary which we celebrate a few days after September 8.

The Deer Park Fire Department, under the Acting Chief of Department Robert Macaluso and in coordination with current chief of the New York City Fire Department Thomas Richardson, both parishioners of Saints Cyril and Methodius, is sponsoring a Mass for First Responders on Sunday, September 12, at the 8:00 AM Mass. This year marks the 20th anniversary of 9/11. On September 11, 2001, 12 members from the Deer Park community lost their lives as a result of the attacks at the World Trade Center and when Flight 93

crashed in Shanksville, Pennsylvania. We will also honor 5 members of the community who were first responders on 9/11 and have since succumbed to 9/11 related illnesses. Each year the Deer Park Fire Department conducts a remembrance ceremony at the firehouse on Lake Ave. After the Mass, a ceremony will be held there at 11:00 AM.

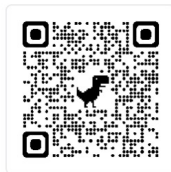
How to Register

All of our families who were enrolled with us for the 2020-2021 Academic Year received the link to the Registration Form for all returning students from last year via email on Friday, August 6th.

Those families who have previously emailed me their interest in being part of our Program this year for the first time, or after not being enrolled for the 2020-2021 year, have also received these specific corresponding forms via email for their new students.

This gentleman asked his employer to make a donation to the food pantry through a payroll deduction to say thank you for the help he received. I never doubt in the goodness of people.

This brings me to the heading on this little newsletter if you will. Parish Social Ministry. This encompasses so much more than outreach and the food pantry. We are here to reach out to the community at large and not just our parish family. As we make this journey, hopefully, we will help people to see what the Catholic Church is all about and why we are an asset to the community. We are after all a community based on service.

I would like to ask you to contemplate what you believe to be the greatest needs in the community. Beyond that I would also like you to think about the best way to address those needs. Of course every program that we know to be important always comes with a price. For the time being I would like you to consider making a monetary commitment to the Parish Social Ministry rather than gift cards to local food stores.

I hope you will help with this endeavor through your thoughts, prayers and discernment where you see us going forward. I thank you for your prayers and I know we can count on you for your time and talents as we proceed in this undertaking.

Current, Active Families:

These families had their students enrolled with us in Family Faith Formation for the 2020-2021 Academic Year. If you are one of these families, you will continue to receive emails to keep you updated with all information regarding Registration. If there is an updated email address that you would prefer us to send information and our Registration form to, please email us.

New, First-Time Students and/or Families:

New families are families with students who have never been enrolled in any Faith Formation Program before. These new families require a copy of the child's Baptismal Certificate and other Sacrament Information in order for our Office to process Registration for their child. If you are one of these families and would like to be put on our potential incoming students email chain, please email us.

Transfer Students and/or Families:

Transfer families are families that were not enrolled in our Program for the 2020-2021 Academic Year, but have been enrolled in another Parish's Faith Formation Program before. These families can be:

- Families transferring from a Parish they received Faith Formation from for the 2020-2021 Year
- Families who have been enrolled with us in the past, but were not enrolled with us for the 2020-2021 Year

To be placed in the appropriate, corresponding program, these families require a copy of the child's Baptismal Certificate, and a transfer letter from your previous Faith Formation Program with what Levels the child completed, and the Sacraments that they received. If you are one of these families and would like to be put on our potential incoming students email chain, please email us.

Registration Disclaimer:

This year, the new school and our Program have to work around each other's schedules in terms of the usage of the building and its classrooms. For this reason, the number of classes offered for certain days and times, depending on the Level, are less than what we are used to. Certain Levels or days may fill up quicker, depending on the space available to us. For this reason, **those who mail back their Registration Forms to us sooner will be given first priority for the availability of having an in-person session**. Please know that we will do our best to work with everyone as best as we can, based on what we have available.
