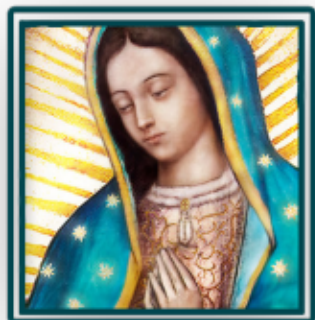

## Weekly Greeting from Ms. Laucella: THANK YOU!

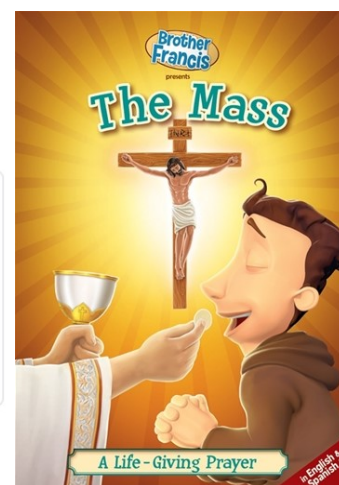
