Mark your calendars!! I am proud to bring to you the world-renowned **PHILIPPINE MADRIGAL SINGERS**. As part of their North American Tour 2023, they will be coming to Ss. Cyril and Methodius for a one evening only performance on **Saturday, May 20, 2023 at 7:00 pm**.

Recognized by the UNESCO as Artists for Peace for "putting their fame and influence to promote cultural diversity, intercultural dialogue and a culture of peace," the Philippine Madrigal Singers is one of the most awarded choral groups in the world, having won all the top prizes in most of the world's prestigious cho-

ral competitions, including the Grand Prix in the 2016 Concorso Internazionale di Guido d' Arezzo, Arezzo, Italy. They hold the distinction of being the first choir in the world to win the prestigious European Grand Prix for Choral Singing twice (1997 and 2007) and the first Asian choir to be accorded

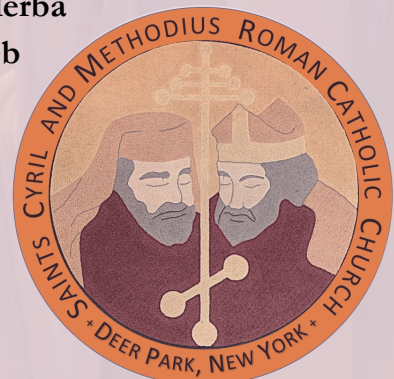

This week, our second half of our older students will also be receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation during their Faith Formation class time. Please be sure to keep them in your prayers, as well!

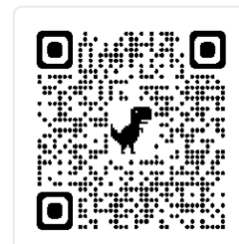
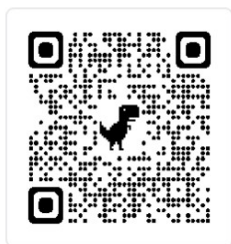
St. Patrick & St. Joseph's Day Mass & Breakfast

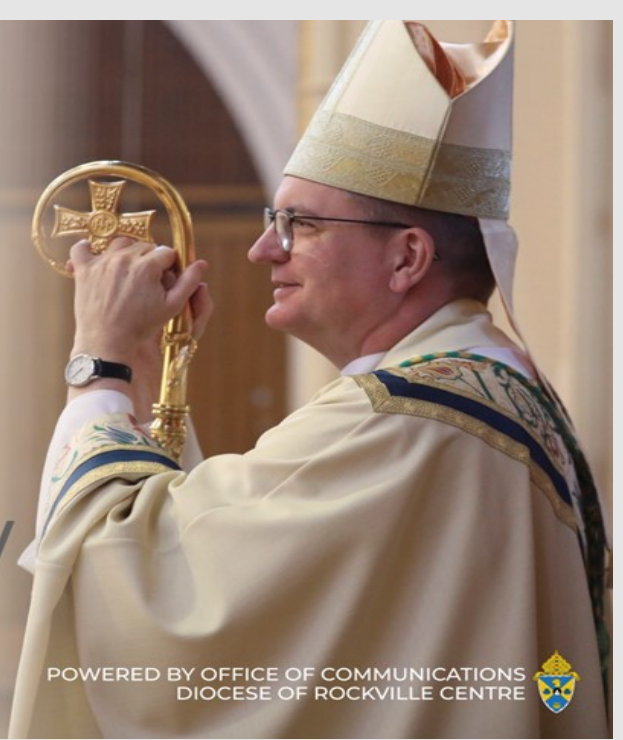

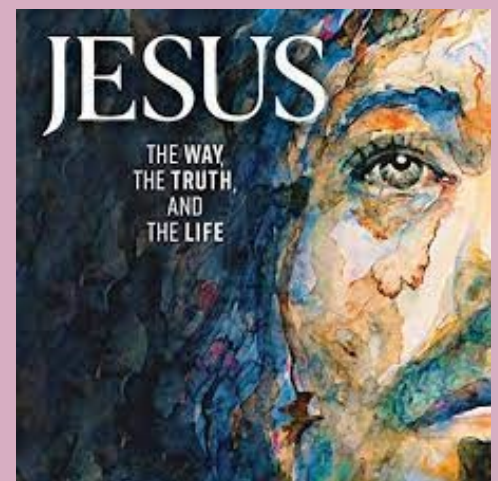
