LENTEN LITURGICAL NOTES

Abstinence and Fasting. All Catholics + who have reached their fourteenth year are bound to abstain entirely from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent. All Catholics between the ages of eighteen and fifty-nine inclusive are also bound to observe the law of fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Two other light meals, which together do not equal a full meal, may be taken during the day. Those whose work or whose health would be impaired are excused from fast and abstinence. Individual conscience should decide proper cause for excuse. A more serious reason is required to excuse oneself from Ash Wednesday and Good Friday fast and absti-

nence.

+ Churches and chapels **SHOULD NOT** be decorated with flowers during the season of Lent, with the exception of **Laetare Sunday** (March 10, 2024), Solemnities (Saint Joseph— March 19), and Feasts. Emphasis should be placed on sparsity and absence.

+ Because it falls during Holy Week this year, the Solemnity of the Annunciation this year is observed during the Easter Season, on April 8, 2024.

+ Beginning with Masses for the **Fifth Sunday of Lent, March 17**, crosses, images, and statues may be covered with violet cloth, per the Passiontide tradition of the Church (red may be used on Palm Sunday and Good Friday). Crosses remain covered until the end of the celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday, but images




WON'T YOU BE MY NEIGHBOR
