

Spring has sprung at least we hope so! It is very busy over here at Parish Social Ministry.

Last month we welcomed 10 new families to our client list. Due to the wonderful parishioners here, we were able to give them not only food but also help them with references to other resources.

We still need Spanish speaking volunteers. We are also looking for a volunteer who can come and be with us on Thursdays.

Please read what we need in the area following this that lets you know what the pantry needs. If everyone picks one or two items to donate it becomes a matter of us getting what is needed without just a few people donating. We certainly never expect anyone to get everything on the list. We have many parishioners so with so many people and one or two items from the list it would be doable to keep the pantry going.

It is important to donate what we have on the list as this is what we need the most. We don't ever want to discourage the donation of any items. However, once again bread if donated early and is put in the bin other heavy things get put on top and then becomes unusable. We are still receiving things that have been opened and used and given the remainder. This we cannot give to anyone. Also, anything without the nutritional label, expired or homemade cannot be given. We realize everyone's heart is in the right place but as a food pantry there are rules issued by the federal and state governments that have to be followed to allow us to continue serving people in Deer Park and North Babylon as well as those who come to us from the Cancer Coalition. We appreciate everything you do for us and our clients.
