

From the Pastor's Desk

The Gratitude That Heals

This Sunday's Gospel Reading (Luke 17:11–19) presents us with a simple yet profound lesson about gratitude. Ten lepers are healed by Jesus, yet only one - a Samaritan, a foreigner - returns to give thanks. The others received the gift but forgot the Giver.



The healing of the lepers reminds us of our own healing in Christ. Through Baptism, Confession, and the Eucharist, the Lord continually touches our wounds and restores us. Yet how often do we take His grace for granted? It is so easy to rush forward with life, enjoying blessings without stopping to acknowledge the Source.

The Samaritan leper teaches us the right response: to return, to fall at the feet of Jesus, and to give thanks. **Gratitude is not merely polite manners; it is the mark of a true disciple.** A grateful heart recognizes God's hand in everything, and such recognition deepens our faith.

This week, let us make time to be like that one leper who came back. In prayer before the Blessed Sacrament (here in Church, every Tuesday from 1 to 7 pm), at family meals, or even in quiet moments of the day, let us say from the heart: "Thank You, Lord." For when we give thanks, we not only honor God. We also open ourselves to receive His peace.

May our lives always echo the words of the Psalmist: "Sing to the LORD a new song, for he has done wondrous deeds." (Psalm 98)



The Diocese of Rockville Center invites those interested in serving as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Lectors to participate in upcoming training.

We kindly ask that you register in advance with a letter from your pastor, as walk-ins cannot be accommodated.

Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion - Part A

- ⇒ This training is required for all new Ministers.
- ⇒ All new Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) must complete BASIC (Part A) training.
- ⇒ If you wish to provide ministry in hospitals, nursing homes, or to the homebound, you must also complete Part B training. Please note: Part A training must be completed before attending Part B training.
- ⇒ Lector Workshop is also available for new and experienced lectors.
- ⇒ You cannot attend *EMHC Part A* and the Lector Workshop on the same day. **Each session must be attended separately.**

Dates and Locations for Liturgical Minister Training:

- Oct. 21 (Tue), 7-10 pm, St. Elizabeth, Melville at the "Msgr. Kane Hall": EMHC Part A, Lector Workshop.
