Never Stop Knocking!

This Sunday's Gospel Reading (Luke 18:1–8) tells the parable of the persistent widow, a woman who never gave up until the unjust judge heard her plea.

What may seem like stubbornness is, in truth, a lesson about faith that endures through prayer.

Jesus tells us to “pray always and not lose heart.” Like the widow, we are called to keep bringing our needs before God with confidence and trust.

Perseverance in prayer is not a sign of doubt, but of deep faith in a Father who listens with love. If even an unjust judge yields to persistence, how much more will our merciful God hear His children!

To “pray always” is **to live each moment aware that God is near**, even when His answers seem delayed. Prayer changes our hearts, strengthens our faith, and reminds us that we are never alone.

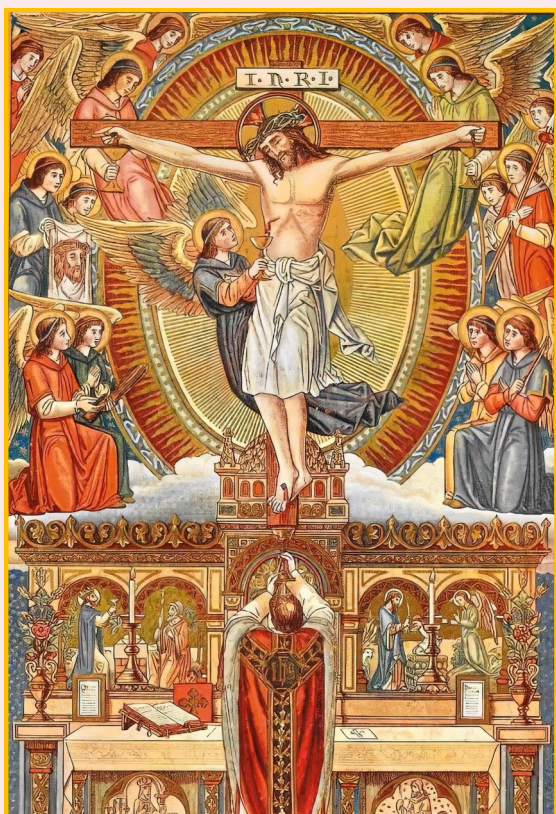

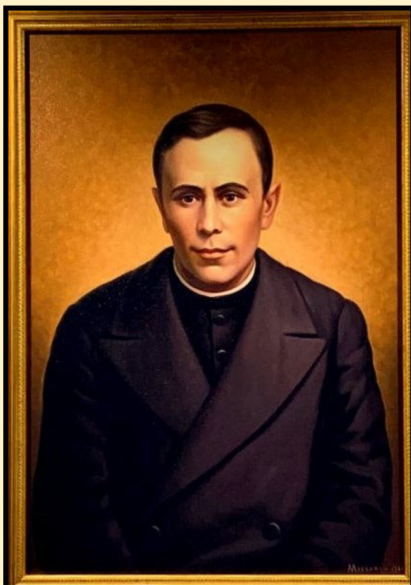

***What is the OCIA (formerly known as the RCIA)?** OCIA stands for “ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS.” It is for non-Catholic adults seeking to join the Catholic Church and for Catholic adults who need to complete the remaining Sacraments of Initiation. Through OCIA, eligible adults learn about the Catholic faith and become full members of the Church. Each year, new members join through OCIA.*

Do you know an adult interested in becoming Catholic who has not been baptized? Any adult who is not baptized and wishes to prepare for Baptism, Confirmation, and First Eucharist should **call Deacon James at the Parish Center: 631-667-4044 (Ext. 100).** This also applies to baptized adults of other Christian faiths.

Adult Catholics who never received First Eucharist and/or Confirmation: If you are a baptized Catholic adult who hasn't completed the Sacraments of Initiation, you are invited to join. Contact Deacon James with any questions or concerns.

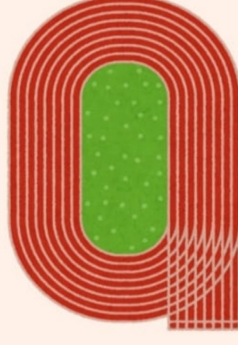
