# Fr. Anthony... our new Pastor

Fr. Anthony Saliba is from the small Mediterranean island of Malta, just off the coast of Italy. He pursued his early studies

in Fine Arts and Design in Rome, Venice, and Milan (Italy). As a seminarian, he completed his theological formation at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome and was ordained to the Priesthood in June 2001. Following his ordination, he continued his academic studies in Rome, where he earned degrees in Sacred Theology and Sacred Art from the same Pontifical University.







Fr. Anthony began his Priestly Ministry in Milan (Italy) in 2005, serving the Ambrosian Diocese in Catholic High Schools and on College Campuses. There, he combined his background in Sacred Art with his pastoral service, fostering both faith and creativity among young people.

In 2016, Fr. Anthony was welcomed into the Diocese of Rockville Centre, where he began his ministry at St. Raphael Parish in East Meadow as Associate Pastor, serving for five years. He later continued his pastoral work for three additional years at St. Rose of Lima Parish in Massapequa.





Most recently, he served as Associate Pastor and later as Parish Administrator at St. Mary's in Manhasset, while also teaching in its parish schools the Latin Language and Literature. During these last seven years, he also ministered as a chaplain at the Nassau County Correctional Facility in East Meadow.

With deep gratitude and joy, Fr. Anthony now begins his new ministry as Pastor of Saints Cyril and Methodius Parish in Deer Park. He is thankful to our Bishop John Barres for entrusting him with this mission.

Confident in the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Parish Patrons, Saints Cyril and Methodius, Fr. Anthony looks forward to journeying together with the Parish community in faith, service, and love of Christ.



# **The OCIA Process in our Parish**

What is the OCIA (formerly known as the RCIA)? OCIA stands for "ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS." It is for non-Catholic adults seeking to join the Catholic Church and for Catholic adults who need to complete the remaining Sacraments of Initiation. Through OCIA, eligible adults learn about the Catholic faith and become full members of the Church. Each year, new members join through OCIA.

Do you know an adult interested in becoming Catholic who has not been baptized? Any adult who is not baptized and wishes to prepare for Baptism, Confirmation, and First Eucharist should call Deacon James at the Parish Center: 631-667-4044 (Ext. 100). This also applies to baptized adults of other Christian faiths.

Adult Catholics who never received First Eucharist and/or Confirmation: If you are a baptized Catholic adult who hasn't completed the Sacraments of Initiation, you are invited to join. Contact Deacon James with any questions or concerns.
